SUGGESTED COURSE ELECTIVES

MPH students in the concentration of Health Policy and Management can choose a maximum of six credit hours for elective courses. This is a list of approved electives based on previous experiences of HPM students. When selecting electives, the student is encouraged to consider career goals and personal academic needs for professional preparation. The student should read the course descriptions in the graduate catalogue, speak with the professor assigned to a course requiring consent of the instructor or prerequisites, and inquire about course content in relation to Public Health.

If a course of potential interest is not on this listing, approval must be obtained from one's CHE academic advisor prior to enrollment. Limited opportunities for a directed independent study in cooperation with a faculty member may be possible. Elective courses are to be selected in consultation with one's academic advisor.
